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COMMUNITY ENGAGEMENT PLAN

Five engagement steps are proposed, however as community engagement is an organic and responsive process, we may adapt these steps as we progress the project, based on our community's feedback.

STEP

1

LET'S TALK ABOUT SOME IDEAS FOR MAIN BEACH

Community and stakeholders put forward their 'big ideas'. No ideas are considered too small or too big. These ideas will form the basis of the Structure Plan for Main Beach. A structure plan represents the bones of a place. You need to get the bones right so the place functions in the best possible way - just like the human body.

STEP

2

HAVE WE GOT THE STRUCTURE RIGHT?

The project team will analyse the site and prepare options for the structure of Main Beach. These options will be discussed with stakeholders and the community in a workshop environment. Attendance at the workshop will be open to the public.

STEP

3

REFINING THE OPTIONS

The project team will review the responses from the workshop and amend or prepare new options. The two preferred options will be placed on our website for comment from the community and stakeholders.

STEP

4

CREATING A PLAN FOR MAIN BEACH

The project team will review the outcome of the online community consultation. From this, a preferred approach will be developed into a Masterplan. This Masterplan will be placed on public exhibition - online and in Council offices - for public comment.

STEP

5

ADOPTING A MASTERPLAN FOR MAIN BEACH

The project team will review submissions received during the public exhibition. Amendments will be made to the Masterplan for final adoption by MidCoast Council.
