On our roads and bridges

Keep an eye out for maintenance/construction crews working on:

- Callaghans Creek Bridge Replacement of timber bridge. Bridge design works are continuing. Access via a side track is in place for all vehicles.
- Gloucester Road (Bo Bo Creek) Reconstruction of approximately 1km stretch near Bo Bo Creek to produce a smoother and safer driving surface. Construction of the road pavement is underway with plans to bitumen seal late next week.
- Thunderbolts Way Rehabilitation the slips, Barrington Reconstruction of 2.1km of road pavement has commenced, stabilisation of the road pavement started last week and will be completed late this week. Bitumen sealing is programmed for next week.
- Potholing and Patching Crews are continuing to carry out potholing works on all sealed roads.
