On our roads and bridges



Keep an eve out for maintenance/construction crews working on:

- Callaghans Creek Bridge Replacement of timber bridge. Dismantling of the timber bridge has been completed. Access via a side track is in place for all vehicles.
- Gloucester Road (Bo Bo Creek) Reconstruction of approximately 1km stretch near Bo Bo Creek to produce a smoother and safer driving surface. The project is now 90% through its construction schedule with sealing expected within 1 to 2 weeks.
- Thunderbolts Way Rehabilitation the slips, Barrington Reconstruction of 2.1km of road pavement has commenced with the first 600m having an initial bitumen seal placed last week. Reconstruction of the next 600m section is underway
- Grading Maintenance grading is currently underway on Carters Road and Bakers Creek.
- Footpaths Maintenance is currently being undertaken to address various trip hazards around town. Maintenance work on footpath and road signage is also being undertaken.
- Shared pedestrian / Cycle path Works have now commenced on the shared pedestrian / cycle path from Showground Road to Dangar Road.
- Potholing and Patching Crews are continuing to carry out potholing works on all sealed roads.
