Bulky waste collection







The scrap metal and bulky waste clean-up will take place in the Gloucester area on 6 - 17 August.

This is a great opportunity to dispose of those larger, unwanted items around the house or in the shed, and have them conveniently picked up from the kerbside where your regular bins are usually placed for collection.

Items must be sorted into two separate piles – one for scrap metal, and the other for general bulky waste. Visit our website for guidelines including what items will be accepted, and how your waste must be presented - non-compliant waste will not be collected and anything rejected and left outside your property is your responsibility to remove. You should place your waste out on 4 August – no earlier, as this will be considered illegal dumping and you could be fined.

Note: electronic waste (eg, TVs, computers) is not accepted.

Tip: If your unwanted items are in reasonable condition / working order, help us reduce the amount of waste going to landfill by trying to re-home them instead.

On our roads and bridges

Keep an eye out for maintenance/construction crews working on:

- Callaghans Creek Bridge Construction of the replacement bridge is programmed for July. Access via a side track around work site is in operation.
- Gloucester Road (Bo Bo Creek) Works are predominantly completed with linemarking and signage to be installed shortly.
- Thunderbolts Way the slips, Barrington Reconstruction of 2.1km of road pavement was completed last week with bitumen seal. The project will be completed when weather conditions allow.
- Gloucester Tops resheeting Final works for gravel resheeting are due for completion in 2 weeks.
- Grading Currently undertaking maintenance grading on Craven Creek Road.
- Footpaths Maintenance is currently being undertaken to address various trip hazards. Other footpath and road signage maintenance is also being undertaken.
- Potholing and patching Crews are continuing to carry out potholing works on all sealed roads.
- Shared pedestrian / cycle path (from Showground Road to Dangar Road) - All preparation works have been done with sealing to be completed shortly.
