To enable your full library membership and collect your membership card you will need to visit us at one of our MidCoast Libraries - Gloucester or Great Lakes library branches within 30 days. You will be asked to bring with you one official form of identification containing your name and current address eg driver's licence.

Items can be borrowed from and returned to any branch of MidCoast Libraries - Gloucester or Great Lakes.

- 20 items at any one time for 3 weeks
- 6 eBooks/eAudio titles for 2 weeks from our Borrowbox collection
- Unlimited eMagazines from our Zinio collection for as long as you like!
- You need your library card to check out items at the library, book a computer or download an eBook.
- We don't charge overdue fines, however member benefits are on hold until overdue items are returned.
- Items damaged or lost will incur a replacement fee

Council meeting

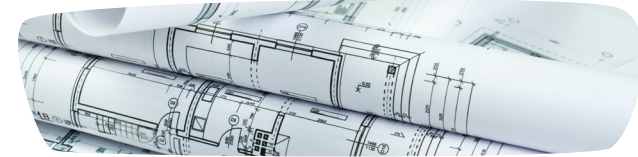


The next Ordinary meeting of council will be held at the Taree administration centre on Wednesday 27 September at 2pm.
