- Callaghan's Creek Bridge Replacement of the timber bridge is continuing. Access via a side track around the work site is in operation.
- Scone Road Reseal extension Upgrading 6.5kms gravel road to bitumen seal. The first half of the project has been completed. Construction of the last half has commenced with shaping of the road pavement now underway.
- Gloucester Tops Road Reseal extension Preparation of road corridor with the focus on the road shoulders.

With all roadworks please remember to travel safely. Observe roadworks signs and speed restrictions, note changed traffic conditions, and proceed with caution.

#### **Education and Training Grants 2018**

Applications are invited from interested persons and businesses for financial assistance grants for 2018 in the following categories:

TAFE course benefits \$1,000 per benefit.
