Temporary road closure

27th Gloucester Tri Challenge - 10 September

To ensure the safety of spectators and competitors in the Mountain Man Tri-Challenge we propose to close the following roads on Sunday 10 September 2017:

Closed between 7.30am and 8.45am:

- **Boundary Street**
- Hume Street/Boundary Street Intersection
- Denison Street/Boundary Street Intersection
- Thunderbolts Way from Boundary Street to Showground Road – for short periods
- Access from Gloucester District Park onto Boundary Street and/or Thunderbolts Way

Closed between 7.45am and 9.00am:

Bucketts Road from Thunderbolts Way to Stanton's

Closed between 8.00am and 10.30am:

- Stantons Lane
- Faulkland Road from Stantons Lane to Barrington West Road (Higgins Crossing)
- Barrington West Road from Faulkland Road to Manchester Road
- Barrington East Road will be a no through road as it will be closed at the Barrington West Road Intersection

Interruption to Traffic between 9.30am and 12.30pm

- Barrington East Road 500 metres south of the junction with Thunderbolts Way
- Bucketts Road at the junction with Thunderbolts Way for 500 metres

These locations will be controlled by Traffic Controllers

- We don't charge overdue fines, however member benefits are on hold until overdue items are returned.
- Items damaged or lost will incur a replacement fee
