On our roads and bridges

Keep an eye out for our maintenance and construction crews in these areas:

- Bulahdelah Lee Street Reconstruction from Crawford to Stroud Street and 175m of Stroud Street / Markwell Road. Works are currently scheduled to finish in early September.
- Esplanade, North Arm Cove Scope of works include upgrading of stormwater drainage - new stormwater culvert and upgrades to pipes under driveways, reconstruction of 350m of gravel road from the eastern end of The Esplanade to create a new bitumen sealed road. Recent rain has delayed completion of the drainage system.
- Booral Road, Crawford River Majority of works complete. Some reworks required to first 100m of roadway to correct minor issues.

Bindii and broadleaf weeds spraying

We will undertake herbicide spraying on sporting fields, parks, pools surrounds, cemeteries, reserves and Council building surrounds throughout the MidCoast region, during July, August, September and October 2018. Only registered herbicides will be used as per label requirements.

This program is subject to weather conditions.

Scheduled areas will be assessed individually and treated as required. Individual areas will be sign-posted at the times of treatment in commonly accessed areas. A list of areas to be treated is available from your local MidCoast Council office.
