## On our roads and bridges

Keep an eye out for our construction crews working in these areas

- The Lakes Way Bungwahl Stage 3 Reconstruction of 700m of The Lakes Way, from 700m south of Seal Rocks Road. The full road reconstruction will improve safety through widening of the road and replacing the road pavement.
- MR90 Wallanbah / Avalon Road Stage 4 Reconstruction of 670m of Avalon Road, from 260m west of Germany Lane through to 410m east of Germany Lane.
- **Tea Gardens Marine Drive Beautification** Reconstruction of Marine Drive and Charles Street.
- Bulahdelah Lee Street Reconstruction of Lee Street from Crawford Street, and 175m of Stroud Street/Markwell Road is underway.
- Arlington Place Wetland Forster Construction of a new wetland to treat stormwater between Arlington Place and The Lakes Way.

With all roadworks please remember to travel safely. Observe roadworks signs and speed restrictions, note changed traffic conditions, and proceed with caution.
