On our roads and bridges

Keep an eye out for our construction crews working in these areas

- **The Lakes Way - Bungwahl Stage 3** - Reconstruction of 700m of The Lakes Way, from 700m south of Seal Rocks Rd.
- **MR90 Wallanbah / Avalon Road - Stage 4** - Reconstruction of 670m of Avalon Road, from 260m west of Germany Lane through to 410m east of Germany Lane.
- **Tea Gardens - Marine Drive Beautification** - Reconstruction of Marine Drive and Charles Street.
- **Bulahdelah - Lee Street** - Reconstruction of Lee Street from Crawford Street to Stroud Street, and 175m of Stroud Street/Markwell Road is underway.
- **Arlington Place Wetland - Forster** - Construction of a new wetland to treat stormwater between Arlington Place and The Lakes Way.
- **Watley Hill Road - Bitumen seal extension program** - Project involves 1.8km extension to the bitumen seal at the eastern end and minor road widening.
