## On our roads and bridges

Keep an eye out for our maintenance crews in these areas:

- **Heavy patching** - Wingham area
- **Road patching** - Taree and Wingham areas
- **Maintenance grading of unsealed roads** - Wallanbah Road, Upper Lansdowne and Comboyne areas
- **Roadside slashing** - Hannam Vale area
- **Roadside vegetation** - Bunyah area

And construction crews who continue work in these areas:

- **The Bucketts Way, Burrell Creek** - Road reconstruction works and replacement of Kellys Bridge.
- **Blackhead Road reconstruction** - 620m either side of Federation Drive.
- **Gloucester Road** - Reconstruction of approx 1km stretch near Bo Bo Creek.
- **Wallanbah Road** - Gravel resheet - Bucca Wauka.
- **Main Street Cundletown** - Road reconstruction. Kerb and gutter improvements are underway in preparation for pavement works between Lansdowne Road and King Street.
- **Manning Regional Art Gallery car park** - Works have commenced to convert existing gravel car park into a new concrete car park.
- **Albert Street** - Asphalt resurfacing between Florence and Macquarie Streets.
- **Mooral Creek Road, Strathcedar** - Works have commenced on a 6-8 week program of gravel resheeting.
- **Pulteney Street** - Reconstruction works have commenced on Pulteney Street between Albert and Wynter Streets. Works include kerb and gutter, pavement, footpaths and retaining walls. There is no on-street parking until completion of the project around mid-August. Through traffic may be disrupted, therefore motorists are advised to use alternate routes.

With all roadworks please remember to travel safely. Observe roadworks signs and speed restrictions, note changed traffic conditions, and proceed with caution.
