Bulky waste collection

The bulky waste clean-up is currently underway in the Great Lakes region and will kick off in the Manning area on 18 June.

This is a great opportunity to dispose of those larger, unwanted items around the house or in the shed, and have them conveniently picked up from the kerbside where your regular bins are usually placed for collection.

Items must be sorted into two separate piles – one for scrap metal, and the other for general bulky waste. Visit our website for guidelines including what items will be accepted, and how your waste must be presented - non-compliant waste will not be collected and anything rejected and left outside your property is your responsibility to remove.

Note: electronic waste (eg, TVs, computers) is not accepted. Tip: If your unwanted items are in reasonable condition / working order, help us reduce the amount of waste going to landfill by trying to re-home them instead.

Notice of intended pesticide application

We have instructed Local Pest Experts to carry out pesticide applications in the Manning Region during June - August.

Pesticides are being used for spiders and cockroaches and will be applied to Council structures including public buildings.

Pesticides used will be selected from the following products: Amdro ant bait, Deltamethrin, Maxforce Gold Gel, APC Permethrin Insecticide Dust, Contrax Blox, Coopex Dust, Biflex Aquamax insecticide, Temprid 75, Stardust Pro.

Residents (including pets) are advised not to enter the structures through any treated areas until the pesticides used have dried, or any special instructions advised on the notice erected on the day(s) of treatment.
