#### Notice of Intended Pesticide Application

We have instructed Local Pest Experts to carry out pesticide applications in the Manning Region during November - January.

Pesticides are being used for spiders and cockroaches and will be applied to Council structures including public buildings.

Pesticides used will be selected from the following products: Amdro ant bait, Deltamethrin, Maxforce Gold Gel, APC Permethrin Insecticide Dust, Contrax Blox, Coopex Dust, Biflex Aguamax insecticide, Temprid 75, Stardust Pro.

Residents (including pets) are advised not to enter the structures through any treated areas until the pesticides used have dried, or any special instructions advised on the notice erected on the day(s) of treatment.

# On our roads & bridges

Keep an eye out for our maintenance crews in these areas:

- Heavy patching Hannam Vale Road
