- Roadside slashing Manning Point area
- Roadside vegetation Nowendoc Road area

And construction crews who continue work in these areas:

- The Bucketts Way, Burrell Creek Road reconstruction works and replacement of Kellys Bridge continuing. Due for completion in November.
- **Diamond Beach Road** Final stage of road reconstruction works between Red Head Road and south of Panorama Drive. Project completion due mid-November.
- Harrington Road Reconstruction works along a 1.27km stretch of Harrington Road is continuing. Due for completion prior to Christmas.
- Bohnock Boat Ramp carpark Upgrades continuing. Due for completion mid November.
- Manning Point Boat Ramp Remains closed this week whilst the contractor completes the final concrete pour and installs the pontoon. Due to be re-opened on 13 November.
- Pelican Bay Bridge Replacement of old timer structure with concrete culverts due to commence mid November. Temporary bypass track will be in operation.
