

THE SALVATION ARMY - MARCH 2021 NSW FLOODS GRANT

- The Salvation Army NSW Flood Grant for people who have suffered significant loss or hardship as a result of the NSW Floods in March 2021 can now be applied for online.
- The grant consists of a \$1,000 payment per household.
- Applications open on Monday 17th May 2021.

How can I apply?

Who can apply?

To be eligible for the grant you must meet all the below criteria:

- Your work or primary place of residence is in a flood impacted area
- You have suffered significant loss or damage to your primary place of residence or primary vehicle; or you have not been able to work due to the floods
- You or anyone in your household has not previously received a NSW Floods grant from The Salvation Army

To complete your application, you will need to provide:

- A form of ID that can confirm your name and primary place of residence address, such as a driver's licence
- A secondary document that confirms your address such as a rate notice or utility bill
- Your bank details
- We may also require supporting evidence such as a referral letter or statutory declaration

When is the deadline to apply?

The grant will remain open until eligible applications have been processed or all available funds are exhausted. We encourage all eligible people to apply as soon as possible to ensure you get the assistance while it's available. If any funds remain, we will assess how we can best use them to provide further assistance.
