



To use your calendar, you'll need to know if your street recycles on Week A or Week B

Look up your street at www.midcoastwaste.com.au/collection-days, where you'll also find what day of the week your collection takes place, or phone us on 1300 290 763, then tick the relevant box below:

I'm Week A recycling week (unshaded)

- Red-lidded general waste bins go out every week
- Yellow-lidded recycling bins go out on unshaded days
- Green-lidded organics bins go out on the alternate week to your recycling (shaded days)

I'm Week B recycling week (shaded)

- Red-lidded general waste bins go out every week
- Yellow-lidded recycling bins go out on shaded days
- Green-lidded organics bins go out on the alternate week to your recycling (unshaded days)

What goes in your red-lidded bin?

General household waste including:

- Soft plastics such as bread bags
- Plastic wrappers and packaging
- Broken glass and crockery
- Disposable nappies
- Food waste
- Polystyrene products eg. pre-packed meat trays
- Clothing and fabric that can't be repurposed



X No hot ashes, liquids, soil or rocks, gas bottles, oil, paint, timber, syringes or medical waste, concrete, building materials, household or car batteries

Hot tip: Drop plastic bags into REDcycle bins at participating supermarkets

What goes in your yellow-lidded bin?

Items suitable for kerbside recycling include:

- Glass bottles and jars
- Cardboard boxes, milk and juice cartons
- Newspapers and magazines
- Rigid plastic containers
- Steel and aluminium cans
- Empty aerosol cans
- Paper products like gift wrap, office paper and junk mail



X No glass or ceramics, nappies, polystyrene products, food scraps, or soft plastics... and don't bag or box your recyclables as our machinery can't open and empty the contents.

Hot tip: Nothing smaller than a credit card (bottle lids should be removed)
