USING YOUR BIN COLLECTION CALENDAR

Your **RED LANDFILL** bin is collected weekly.

Your **YELLOW RECYCLING** bin is collected fortnightly, on the weeks highlighted in yellow on your calendar.

If you have a **GREEN GARDEN ORGANIC** bin it is collected on alternate fortnights, shown in green on your calendar.

Scan the QR code on the front, or call 1300 290 763 to find out which day of the week bins in your street are collected.

When placing your bins out for collection:

- Please place your bins out the night before collection day
- Ensure your bins are kept at least 1 metre apart from each other to allow easy access by collection trucks
- Position your bins a reasonable distance away from letterboxes, trees and parked cars
- Make sure your bins are not obstructing driveways or footpaths, and they are not a trip hazard for pedestrians
- Don't overfill your bins, and ensure the lid is closed properly

WHAT GOES WHERE?

Placing the right things in the right bins helps us reduce the amount of waste ending up in our landfills. Use the handy reference guide below, or visit our website for a full A-Z listing.



IMPORTANT REMINDER Batteries of any kind don't belong in any bin. They contain harmful substances like mercury, cadmium and lead that can be dangerous or cause fire when mixed with other waste streams. Batteries also cause environmental damage if they end up in landfill. To dispose of batteries, drop them at your nearest Waste Management Centre, free of charge all year round.
