



MidCoast Council Bulky Waste Cancellation

Unfortunately the current Covid-19 pandemic has forced the cancellation of the 2020 Bulky Waste collection in the MidCoast Council area. This difficult decision was made in conjunction with Council staff following the earlier suspension of the service.

The collections were cancelled due to concerns for the health of our staff in handling items that could be infected, and our need to comply with the Federal Government directive not to undertake non-essential services. The bulky waste clean-up is considered non-essential given it does not include waste that could rot or decay.

The bulky waste clean-up was scheduled to run over twenty weeks to enable coverage of the entire MidCoast Council local government area. Unfortunately we do not have the availability of the specific vehicles used in the bulky waste collection to enable us to postpone the collection to a later date in the year, should restrictions be relaxed.

With household wheelie bin services we request residents place bins out the night before their normal collection day as run times have been staggered to allow us to ensure our staff are able to implement social distancing at our depots at the start and end of their shifts.
