A white metal plate with black numbers indicating the rural number allocated to your property. This plate should be displayed adjacent the property entrance and be easily read without obstructions from trees etc.

Your rural address plate will need to be picked up from designated Council office.

A galvanised steel post with a black delineator attached at the top and reflective numbers indicating the rural number allocated to your property. Your rural address post will be installed by Council staff.
