

LOCAL GOVERNMENT ACT 1993

PROPOSAL TO DISSOLVE MIDCOAST COUNTY COUNCIL

A proposal, made pursuant to section 383(1) of the *Local Government Act 1993*, has been received from Mid-Coast Council to dissolve MidCoast County Council and transfer its assets, liabilities and functions to Mid-Coast Council.

The proposal has the support of MidCoast County Council.

MidCoast County Council, which trades under the name of MidCoast Water, is responsible for the provision, care, control and management of water supply and sewerage works, services and facilities within the local government area of Mid-Coast Council.
