The first part of the Figtrees on the Manning development will get underway soon, starting with the construction of a pedestrian/cycle bridge over Browns Creek, which will link the Bicentennial Gardens to Nelson/Pitt Street at Chatham.

This great new addition to our walkways is part of a larger project to improve pedestrian and cycle access across the Manning, with the aim of creating a continuous pedestrian/cycle path from Harry Bennett Park through to the Taree Recreation Grounds.

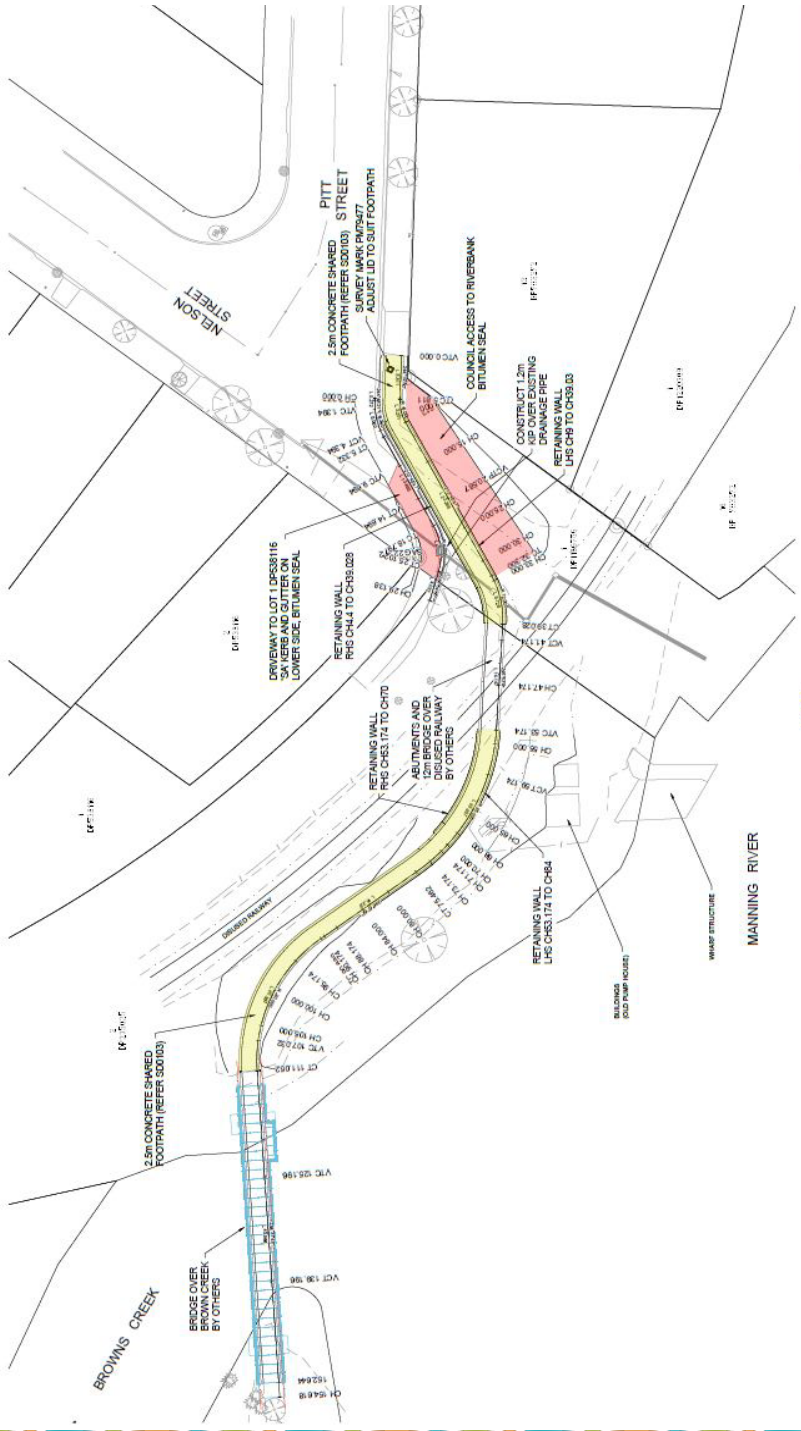
The Bushland Health Group has engaged Fleetwood Urban to design and construct the bridge and work is expected to take about two months to complete, weather permitting.

While approvals and licences are still being obtained, we wanted to give advance notice to residents in the vicinity of the project.

Once work begins there will be no disruption to driveway access for residents and minimal impact on traffic and boating in the area. Works will be undertaken during normal building construction days and times and work will commence on the connecting pathways upon completion of the bridge.

Contractors Fleetwood Urban will notify residents closer to the works commencing with more detailed information including start date, hours/ days of operation and a contact person should there be any issues.
