Objective:

To prevent damage to dune vegetation by adjoining landowners.

Prohibited Activities:

Structures

The erection or construction of fences, playground equipment, barbecues, clothes hoists, paths, etc in dune areas is prohibited.

Storage

The storage of boats, caravans, cars, compost heaps or any material, other than by Great Lakes Council in dune areas is prohibited.

Restricted Activities:

Clearing

Clearing of natural dune growth is not permitted. The only exception is that a two (2) metre strip of the reserve adjacent to private property may be selectively cleared of dune growth to provide a transition zone between dune growth and lawns.

Access

Access to beaches is to be limited to those accesses designated by Great Lakes Council.
