

Getting to Forster Waterside



Forster Waterside is accessed by walking trails along Wallis Lake. Pedestrian crossings are available to cross Head Street, and a pedestrian underpass connects to the Forster - Tuncurry Bridge. All day parking is located a short walk from the shopping area.



Forster Waterside is located on the **NSW Coastline Cycleway**, which provides a 13km off road cycle path linking Tuncurry and Forster.



Bicycle parking rails are provided along Wharf Street and Wallis Street. Secure bicycle parking is available at Wharf Street (see Council for access details).



Forster Buslines operates services 303,304,305 which access Forster Waterside. Eggins operates a limited regional service between Taree and Forster.

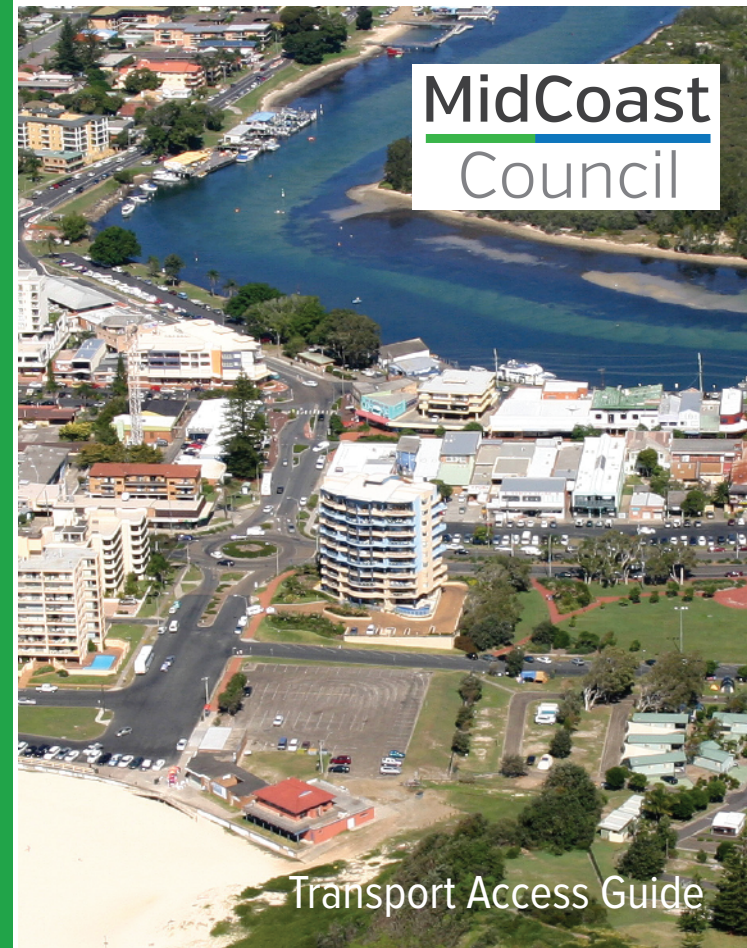
