



# **SEVERE** **RESTRICTIONS** **NOW IN FORCE\***



## **Business, commercial and industrial**

**Water use is limited to economic viability production.**

### **Nurseries and market gardens**

Water can only be used with direct MidCoast Council permission.

### **Motor dealer vehicle washing**

The use of machine washers with recirculation is banned. Hand washing with a bucket only is allowed.

### **Mobile water tankers**

Only to be used for firefighting, construction, inside residential, or public health purposes. Where possible, use other water source.

### **Construction industry**

Hoses used must be fitted with a hand-held trigger to shut off flow when released.

### **Non-production outdoor use**

Only use recycled or grey water on gardens.

No sprinklers or garden irrigation systems.

No car or boat washing.

No swimming pool top-ups.

### **Save water indoors too!**

While not part of Level 4 restrictions, please be water-wise and consider how you can save water indoors too.

- Check you have no dripping taps or plumbing leaks.
- Consider how your business can collect and reuse grey water
- Implement production water saving options wherever possible.
