SEVERE RESTRICTIONS NOW IN FORCE*



Business, commercial and industrial

Water use is limited to economic viability production.

Nurseries and market gardens

Apply for written exemption for water to be used - demonstrate how water saving will be achieved and why alternate water sources are not available.

Motor dealer vehicle washing

Hand washing with a bucket only for safety reasons eg windscreens and lights.

Mobile water tankers

Only filled between 8am and 8pm from approved point. Only to be used for firefighting, inside residential, or public health purposes. Where possible, use other water source.

Construction industry

Minimise all water use on the work site. Hoses used must be fitted with a hand-held trigger to shut off flow when released.

Commercial or industrial outside use

Refer to the Residential Fact Sheet.

Boat motor flushing 3 minutes on grassed area. Commercial pools need to minimise water use for pool top-ups.

Water for livestock permitted.

Use of alternate or recycled water permitted.

Non-production outdoor use

Only use recycled or grey water on gardens. No sprinklers or garden irrigation systems. No car or boat washing.

Save water indoors too!

Please be water-wise and consider how you can save water indoors too.

- Check you have no dripping taps or plumbing leaks.
- Consider how your business can collect and reuse grey water
- Implement production water saving options wherever possible.
