On our roads and bridges

Keep an eye out for maintenance/construction crews working on:

- **Callaghans Creek Bridge** - We are preparing tender documentation for the construction of the new bridge. Construction of the bridge will be completed in early 2019. Access is via a temporary side track.
- **Thunderbolts Way - the slips, Giro** - Reconstruction of 2.1km of road pavement has been completed with preliminary bitumen seal. A final seal is scheduled for November.
- **Shared Pedestrian/Cycle Path** (from Showground Road to Dangar Road) - Installation of bollards and approx 40m of fencing, to complete the project, is programmed for next week.
