Education and Training Grants 2019

Applications are invited from interested persons and businesses for financial assistance grants for 2019 in the following categories:

Tertiary Assistance Grants \$2,000 per grant. For intending or currently enrolled university applicants who have not previously received a grant.

TAFE Course Benefits \$1,000 per benefit.

Apprenticeships/Traineeships Subsidies Up to \$6,000 over three years to assist local businesses to employ an apprentice or trainee.

Criteria University and TAFE applicants need to have completed six years of their schooling at a Gloucester basin School (Booral to Barrington). For the business subsidies, applicants need to be locally owned or operated businesses.

Note All grants, benefits, scholarships and subsidies will be awarded on the basis of the quality of the written application.
