Bulky Waste



The scrap metal and bulky waste clean-up will take place again this year. It kicks off on Monday 23 March for residents in the Gloucester region, with Great Lakes to follow from 4 May, and Manning from 29 June.

Bushfire Recovery - Waiver of fees & charges

Anyone who lost their home in the recent bushfires is eligible for a range of exemptions from rates and Council fees and charges. Council has waived all fees and charges for the rebuilding of homes destroyed by the bushfires, and a range of other fee exemptions are in place.
