## COVID-19 response

We will be closing a number of non-essential services to help reduce the spread of the virus in the community.

The Manning Entertainment Centre and all Council owned pools in the region, including the YMCA facilities in Taree, Forster and Wingham have already been closed.

From 5pm Friday 27 March the following Council services will close their doors:

We will continue to provide essential services to the community including water provision and sewer services, road maintenance and rubbish collection, and the following facilities remain open for business:

- Gloucester's Service NSW and Services Australia (Centrelink) agencies
- Waste Management Centres

To prioritise weekly and fortnightly rubbish collections, the annual bulky waste collections have also been suspended.

Public amenities will remain open while they can be appropriately cleaned and hygiene facilities provided, but may be closed on short notice.
