On our roads and bridges



Keep an eye out for our maintenance and construction crews in these areas:

- Bulahdelah Lee Street Reconstruction from Crawford Street to Stroud Street and 175m of Stroud Street / Markwell Road. Works are predominately complete, with final delineation of the roundabout programmed for late October.
- Jimmys Beach Sand Transfer System Construction of a Sand Transfer System to relocate stockpiled sand from Winda Woppa to Jimmys Beach. Installation of the pipeline to Winda Wippa is ongoing, construction of the pump station at Winda Woppa continues with the focus on the walls over the coming weeks.
- The Lakes Way, Bungwahl Reconstruction of 320m of road pavement south of Bungwahl, the last stage of a multi-year program that started in the village of Bungwahl. Final bitumen seal coat to be arranged.
- Water Street, North Arm Cove Stormwater drainage works to rectify nuisance flooding issues, including the construction of a drainage pipeline and removal of the existing open drain. Water Street between Cove Boulevard and North Arm Cove foreshore will remain closed to vehicle access while placement of drainage lines continues this week, however pedestrian access to the foreshore remains in place. Works anticipated to be completed by the end of November. Recent delays have occurred due to wet weather.
- Bombah Point Road, Bombah Point Upgrading a rural gravel road to a bitumen seal. The program of recent years to extend the bitumen seal along Bombah Point Road is continuing this year. Works are now largely completed with housekeeping occurring this week.
- Coomba Road, Coomba Works have started on various stormwater pipe replacements. These works will form part of a road rehabilitation effort that is scheduled to commence in late October/early November.
- Boondelbah Road, Tea Gardens Reconstruction works on the 400m length of road are programmed to commence late October, with works to be completed in mid-November.

With all roadworks please remember to travel safely. Observe roadworks signs and speed restrictions, note changed traffic conditions, and proceed with caution.
