On our roads and bridges

Keep an eye out for our maintenance and construction crews in these areas:

- Bulahdelah Lee Street pavement reconstruction. Stage 1 of the project in Lee & Stroud Streets is coming to a conclusion with asphalt works finished last week. Works scheduled for completion in October.
- Jimmys Beach Sand Transfer System works along The Boulevarde for the pipeline have started, and work on the pump station at Winda Woppa continues. Programmed for completion early 2019.
- Marine facilities, Tea Gardens second pontoon and shelter at existing wharf. Works are scheduled for completion mid to late October.
- **Dredging of The Gut, Tea Gardens** Dredging works have been completed. Decommissioning of the dredge has started and is expected to be concluded by the end of the month.
- The Lakes Way, Bungwahl pavement reconstruction. Bitumen sealing occurred last week with minor housekeeping works planned for this week. Works will be completed prior to the mid-October forecast.
- Water Street, North Arm Cove Stormwater drainage works to rectify nuisance flooding issues. Works scheduled for completion at the end of the month.
- Bombah Point Road, Bombah Point Upgrading rural gravel road to bitumen seal.
