Notice of approval - amendment to DCP

An amendment to Part J of the Greater Taree Development Control Plan 2010 was adopted by Council at its Ordinary Meeting on 28 November 2018 and will come into effect on the date of this notice.

The key reason for the amendment is to include provisions for Dual Occupancies (detached) in the Primary Production (RU1) zone. The application of these provisions is reliant on an upcoming amendment to the Greater Taree Local Environmental Plan 2010.
