Herbicide spraying

We will be carrying out herbicide spraying from 8 October - 30 November of the lower Barrington, Gloucester and Upper Manning Rivers to target Senegal Tea Plant.

As a precaution residents are advised to refrain from using, drinking or swimming in the water for 96 hours following treatments. Residents who pump from the river to fill water tanks for human consumption are advised to do so prior to commencement of works, and not resume pumping for 96 hours following treatments.

Only qualified operators will be undertaking works. Herbicides Weedmaster Duo, Sixgun 360, Biochoice 360 and/or Glymac 360 (360g/L glyphosate) will be used as per the requirements of the label and APVMA permit 9907.

This program is subject to weather conditions.
