### Roadside vegetation spraying program

We will be carrying out herbicide spraying on roadsides and reserves during the months July, August, September and October 2019 within the entire MidCoast Local Government area, to target general vegetation, grasses, annual, perennial and environmental weeds.

This program is subject to weather conditions. Only qualified operators will be undertaking works. Subject to availability and need, registered herbicides Herbicides Weedmaster Duo, Sixgun 360, Biochoice 360, Glymac 360 (360g/L glyphosate), and/or Metsun 600, Lynx WG, Kenmet and/or Grazon extra will be used as per the requirements of the label and APVMA off label permit 9907 where applicable.

Scheduled areas will be assessed individually and treated as required. Individual areas will be sign-posted at the times of treatment in commonly accessed areas.

A list of areas to be treated is available at our offices.
