In accordance with the provisions of the Roads Act 1993 (Part 9 Division 2) and the Roads Regulation 2008 (Part 6), it is hereby notified that MidCoast Council proposes to issue a Public Gate Permit to Silknote Pty Ltd of Lot 16 DP 754421, 10 Baradeen Road, Khatambuhl, for the installation of a Public Gate (comprising a stock grid & gate) on Baradeen Road, Khatambuhl, at a location being 40 metres from the commencement of Baradeen Road.
