Obtaining a MidCoast Council beach access vehicle permit gives you entry to a range of beautiful, unspoilt beaches in both the Manning and Great Lakes regions.

By obtaining a permit you are also agreeing to comply with rules regarding where and when you can access the beach.

We have 12 month permits with a pensioner/senior discounted option, 30 day permits, restricted permits and professional fishing permits.
