Recovery and resilience grants

If you're a community group looking to support recovery or build resilience against future disaster events, you may be eligible for up to \$15,000 in grant funding. Round two of our disaster recovery and resilience grants is open until Monday 3 January 2022 for community development initiatives and capacity-building projects and activities.

Projects delivered by successful community groups in Round one of the program included training workshops for young people, replacement of damaged equipment, installation of water tanks at community halls, and provision of first aid equipment.
