Bulky Waste collection



While the Bulky Waste kerbside collection is an eagerly anticipated annual event, it covers close to 50,000 households in 195 localities and takes around 4 months from start to finish. weather permitting. That's why it's important to put your waste out on the date specified for your location - no earlier or you could be fined.

The collection kicks off in the Manning area next week, with residents of the following locations invited to place waste out this weekend 25/26 February.

Belbora*, Black Head, Bucca Wauka*, Bunyah*, Burrell Creek, Diamond Beach, Dyers Crossing, Failford, Firefly, Hallidays Point, Hillville, Kiwarrak, Koorainghat, Krambach, Kundibakh, Nabiac, Possum Brush, Rainbow Flat, Red Head, Tallwoods Village, Tipperary, Wang Wauk.
