## **Pesticide application**

We have instructed Local Pest Experts to carry out pesticide applications in the Forster region, which are scheduled to be carried out from 1 April to 31 May 2023.

Pesticides are being used for spiders and cockroaches. Pesticide products will be applied to Council structures including public buildings.

Pesticides used will be selected from: Biflex Aquamax insecticide, Synergy Pro ant bait, Starrdust Pro, Maxforce Gold Gel, Enviromax Deltamethrin, Temprid 75, Termidor and Derman Duo.

Residents (including pets) are advised not to enter the premises through any treated areas until the pesticides used have dried, or any special instructions advised on the notice erected on the day(s) of treatment.

## Bulky waste collection



While the Bulky Waste kerbside collection is an eagerly anticipated annual event, it covers close to 50,000 households in 195 localities and takes around 4 months from start to finish, weather permitting. That's why it's important to put your waste out on the date specified for your location – no earlier or you could be fined.

The collection is underway in the Manning area, with residents of the following locations invited to place waste out this weekend 11/12 March:

Bohnock, Bootawa, Caffreys Flat, Cooplacurripa, Dollys Flat, Glenthorne, Karaak Flat, Killawarra, Kimbriki, Knorrit Flat, Manning Point, Mitchells Island, Mondrook, Mount George, Number One, Old Bar, Oxley Island, Pampoolah, Purfleet, Saltwater, Taree South, The Bight, Tinonee and Wallabi Point.
