

Construction is the second largest contributor to the MidCoast economy. Employment in this sector has grown by 65% since 2018, reaching 4,556 employed persons. The industry's Value Add, \$362.1M, has experienced a noteworthy 17.9% growth since 2018, far surpassing benchmark regions.

Representing 21% of all total registered businesses, the industry includes Building Construction, Heavy and Civil Engineering, and Construction Services. Construction is a key job growth industry and due to the high demand for residential housing, coupled with a dynamic portfolio of planned projects in the region, Construction is expected to remain a key economic contributor.
