The online map not only highlights major road and bridge projects that are in already in progress, but includes an overview of what's coming up for the rest of this financial year. Click on a locational pin for full project details, including what type of work is being undertaken, start and finish dates, the project's budget and the funding source.

The interactive map is a new addition to our website and aims to help motorists understand where they can expect to see improvements to our road and bridge network. It highlights major rehabilitation and reconstruction works to be undertaken in 2023-24 where we will invest \$60 million, but excludes our business-asusual maintenance program (an additional \$15 million).
