

The Administrative and Support Services industry is of moderate size but demonstrates strong growth potential, driven by both local dynamics and broader economic trends. In 2024, the industry's Value Add reached \$162 million—a 20% increase from \$134.4 million in 2020. Business numbers also grew significantly, rising from 220 in 2020 to 304 in 2024.

Notably, the steady rise in non-employing businesses suggests that the MidCoast is becoming an attractive hub for professional remote workers, including self-employed individuals.
