

The Information, Media, and Telecommunications industry is an emerging growth sector in the MidCoast region. Although it ranks 18th in terms of Value Add at \$62.5 million, it has recorded the highest growth since 2020—an impressive 186% increase. This surge is largely driven by two key sub-industries: Telecommunication Services and Library and Other Information Services. Employment in the sector has also expanded significantly, rising by 85% to 400 people.

The increasing demand from new and existing businesses for internet and telecommunications infrastructure, combined with a growing population of remote workers, is fostering a dynamic environment of innovation and diverse skillsets. This momentum is fuelling strong industry activity and positioning the sector as a vital contributor to the region's economic progress.
