

The Manufacturing industry is a dynamic and high-potential growth sector in the MidCoast region, employing 1,903 people. It supports a range of niche, export-oriented businesses, with key subindustries including Food Product Manufacturing, Wood Product Manufacturing, and Fabricated Metal Product Manufacturing. With a stable Industry Value Add of \$253.7 million—reflecting 6.8% growth since 2020—Manufacturing ranks second in regional exports, contributing \$339.1 million in 2024.

The adoption of advanced manufacturing technologies and ongoing productivity improvements are expected to drive further growth, positioning the sector as a key contributor to the MidCoast's economic future.
